


















### INSIGHTFUL TALK ON ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE IN HIGHER EDUCATION HOSTED


### ITU CELEBRATES INTERNATIONAL DAY OF EDUCATION.

### PANEL ON HISTORY OF ELECTIONS IN PAKISTAN SPARKS AN INSIGHTFUL DISCUSSION

Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences (FHSS) at ITU earlier hosted a panel discussion on the history of elections in Pakistan, drawing in students and faculty members.

The distinguished panelists, Dr. Ali Usman Qasmi, Associate Professor of History at Lahore University of Management Sciences (LUMS), and Mr. Tahir Mehdi, Head of Lok Sujag, a digital media platform, provided a comprehensive analysis of Pakistan's electoral process, tracing its development from the early years to the present. They highlighted the impact of various factors such as political parties, political elites in the early years of Pakistani history, electoral reforms, and the influence of non-political actors on election outcomes.

Of particular interest was the discussion on how political elites of the early period and non-political interventions have affected the history and process of elections, as well as the significant general elections that led to various critical incidents in Pakistani history. The panelists also highlighted the role played by political activists and civil society during this historical process, which marks the struggle for fair and free elections.
